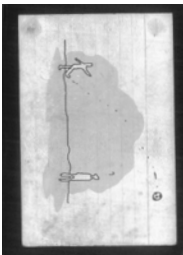

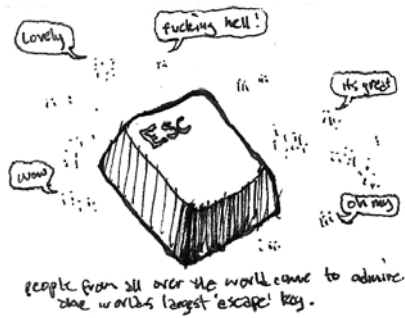

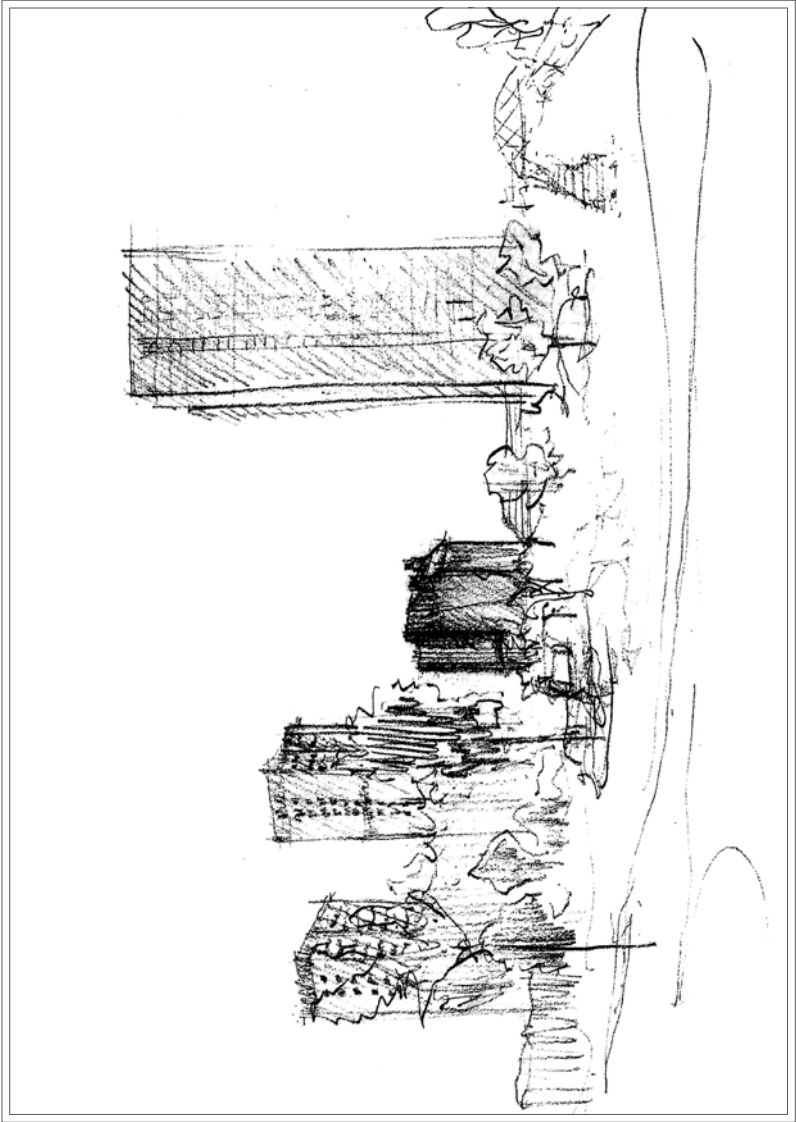


Old Tenement, Gorbals

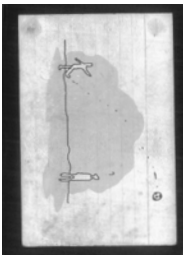

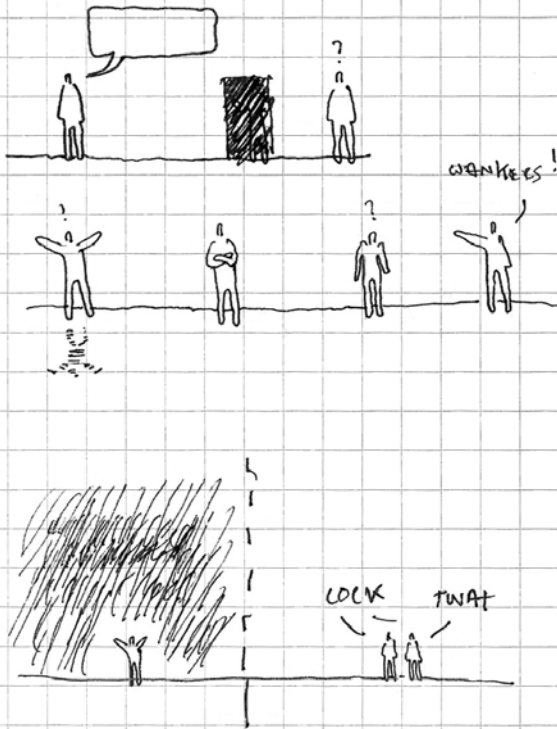
The page that precedes this in my sketchbook describes my lack of motivation to do Hole in my Pocket work, and in particular, work for this publication.

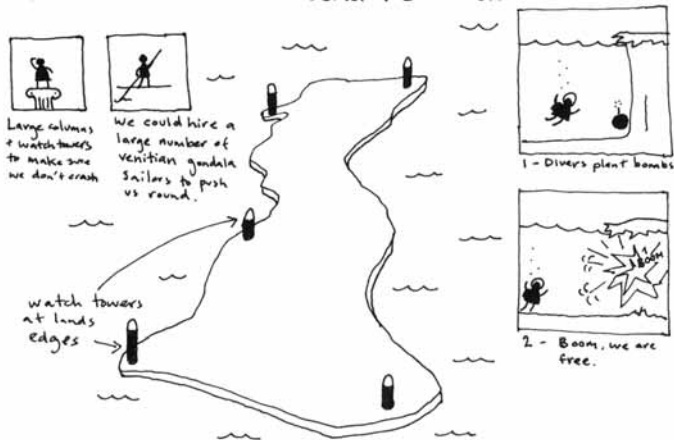
